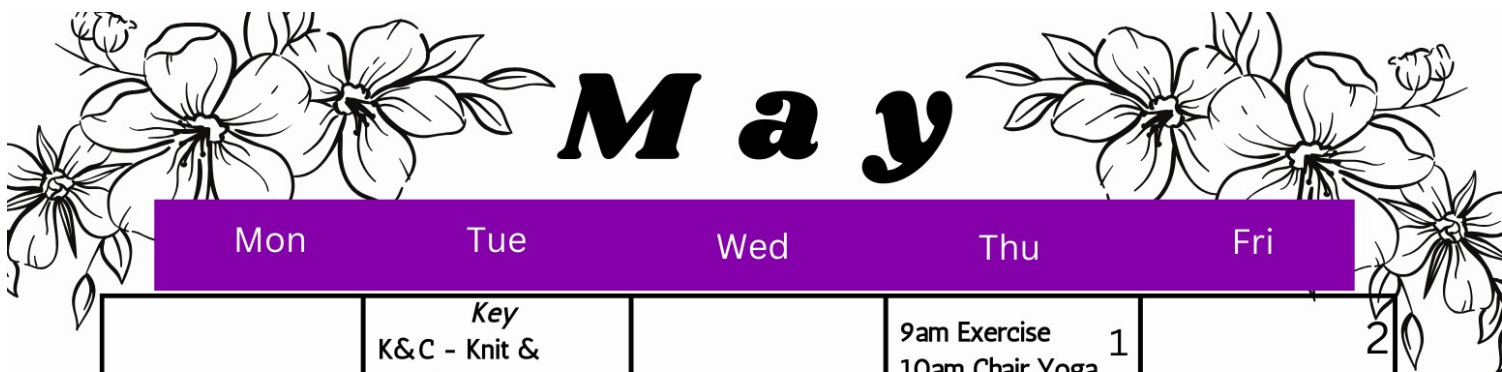
We're open from 8:30am-4pm Monday to Friday.

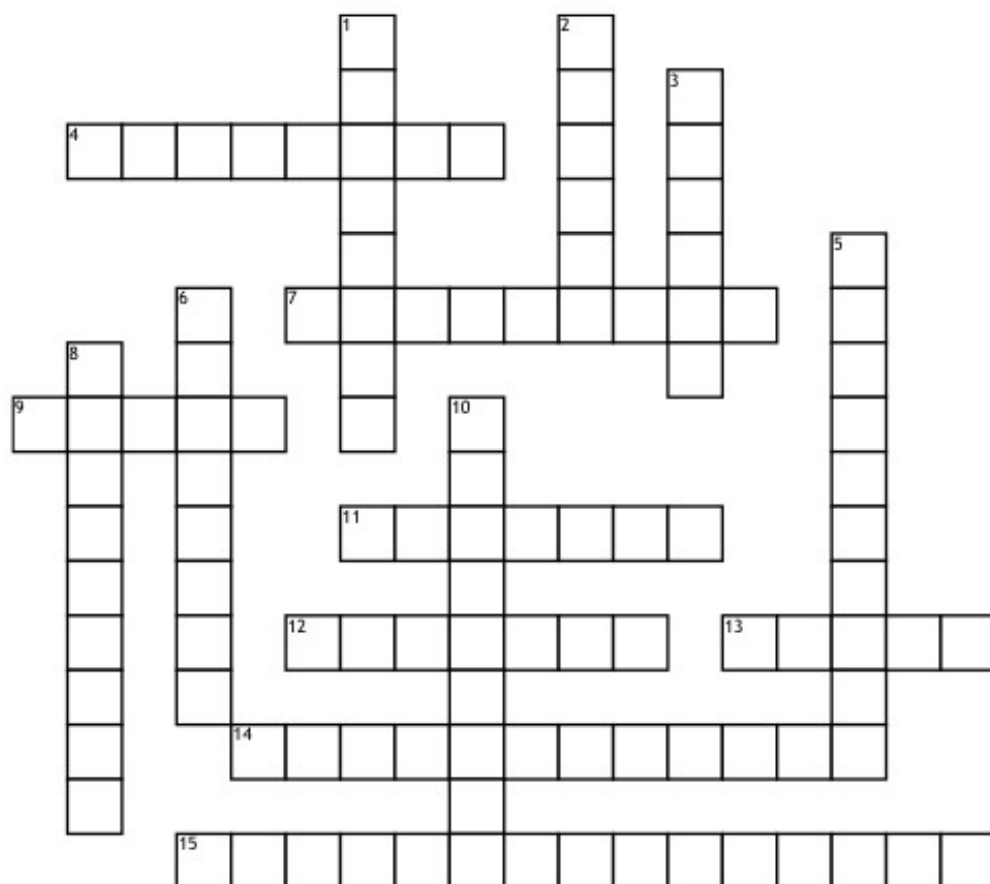
